

ACCIDENT & RELEASE FORM

I/We, _____, the parent(s)/guardian(s) of the minor
_____ (the "Registrant"), my/our son/daughter/ward, give
permission for the Registrant to participate in the _____ program sponsored
by The Randolph Recreation Dept. I/We understand that the Recreation Dept. will provide supervision for the
safety and well-being of the Registrant and I/We agree that the Registrant will abide by the rules of the Recreation
Dept. and the Town of Randolph and will follow the instructions of all supervisory staff, including sponsors,
employees, volunteers and other personnel while participating in the aforementioned Activity/Program.

I/We recognize the risk of injury or accident related to the Activity/program. I/We also, acknowledge that the
Registrant may not participate in the Activity unless I/We waive claims, which I/We may have arising from the
Registrant's participation in the activity/program. Accordingly, in order to permit the registrant to participate in
the Activity/Program, I/We hereby waive, release and otherwise discharge the Town of Randolph, the Recreation
Dept., and each of their respective members, officers, employees, and agents, including all supervisory staff, from
any and all claims which I/We may now or in the future have arising from the Registrant's participation in the
Activity/Program.

I/We also, hereby, authorize that first aid and emergency medical treatment is administered to the Registrant, if
reasonably necessary.

BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS: Programs are intended to be fun and safe learning experiences for our children.
We encourage RESPECT for self, for management team, for all participants and our equipment and supplies. The
Recreation Dept. has adopted the following policies: Any action on the part of a participant that is considered
dangerous or destructive or deemed inappropriate will result in the immediate dismissal of said Registrant.

REFUND POLICY: The Randolph Recreation Dept. has a NO REFUND POLICY.
Refunds are only given when the Recreation Dept. cancels a program; the program reaches capacity, or when
changes are made by the Recreation Dept. that forces a participant to be unable to attend. If you feel that you
should get a refund, because of the above mentioned reasons, send The Recreation Dept. a written statement as
to the circumstances of the request. The Recreation Dept. will review the letter at their next regularly scheduled
meeting and take a vote on the request. If the refund is granted, the check could take up to 30 days to process.

WAIVER: No Child will be allowed to participate in activities, field trips, swimming or other programs, unless a
parent or legal guardian has granted permission.
